Trophy Presentation Evening

The 2012 Championship Winners and Runners-Up Trophies, and other major presentations will be made at the President's Dinner / Presentation Evening on Saturday 8th December 2012. (6.30-7pm)

Club Championship

Saturday 21st, 28th April & Sunday 22nd, 29th April 2012

The President's Trophy was inaugurated as the Club Championship Perpetual Trophy in 1997 to commemorate Ipswich Golf Club's Centenary. The Club Championship is a 72 Hole Single Stroke event.

Junior

Saturday 21st, 28th April & Sunday 22nd, 29th April 2012

The Keith Buffey Junior Memorial Trophy was donated by Betty Buffey and Family in memory of Club stalwart and junior golf promoter Keith Buffey. This is the Junior Champion Perpetual Trophy and the Championship is played as a 72 Hole Single Stroke event. Betty Buffey sponsors this event each year. Junior golfers are under 18 yrs of age.

Other Championships

Saturday 21st, 28th April & Sunday 22nd, 29th April 2012

"B" Grade, "C" Grade, Senior and Veteran Championships played as 72 Hole Single Stroke events. Senior Players are 50-59yrs and Veterans 60+ yrs.

Dr Neill McCann donated this Trophy in memory and recognition of the golfing exploits and memory of Dr William Tweddell who was British Amateur Champion 1927, Runner Up 1935, Walker Cup Captain 1928 and 1936 and Captain Royal and Ancient St Andrews G.C.-1961-62.

The winner of this event is determined by adding the 4 Single Stableford Rounds. This event has proven to be one of our most popular events.

The Single Handicap Match Play Championship is an Honour Board Event.

A new format is being trialled in 2012 with 16 players qualifying to play the event after 2 single stableford qualifying rounds. The matchplay is played on a Sunday unless both players agree to play on an alternate day before the next round. Full handicap difference is used to determine "shots given".

Ipswich Cup

The Ipswich Cup was inaugurated in 1961 in an endeavour to lift the image of Ipswich Golf Club by attracting players from throughout SE Qld. Since the introduction of the City of Ipswich Open in 1982, it has been played as a Closed 18 Hole Single Stroke Event. The date this year is **Saturday 16th June 2012**.

E.M. Scott Cup

The Ipswich Club Secretary, Eric Scott, had been supplying information to the "Golf in Australia" Magazine, but on one or two occasions his notes did not appear and he complained. The Magazine offered remuneration but this was refused. It then offered to donate a Cup to Ipswich to be known as the Eric M. Scott Cup. This was accepted in August 1926 and is played in the form of a Closed 18 Hole Single Stroke event. This event is scheduled for the **Saturday 27th October 2012**.

Ipswich England Cup

During World War II, Ipswich Golf Club sent food parcels to Britain. When the new Ipswich Course was opened in 1950, Rushmere Golf Club (England) sent a Trophy in recognition of support during the war. Rushmere Golf Club has continued to maintain a relationship with various visitations and commemorative items over the years. This "closed event" is Saturday 17th March 2012.

Fred T Hooper Bowl

The well-known Hooper Family donated the Rose Bowl in 1973, and since 1987 it has been Ipswich Golf Club's major Four Person Ambrose Trophy. This event is scheduled for **Saturday 3rd March 2012**.

Foursomes Championships

Sunday 17th June: MIXED 36 HOLE FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIP

Sunday 29th July: MEN'S 36 HOLE FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIP

Tuesday 25th Sept.: LADIES 36 HOLE FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIP

The Mixed Foursomes incorporates the Fay and Danny Kaye Memorial Shield, presented on the day for the lowest 36 Hole Nett score. Fay and Danny both served their fellow players on Committees of the Ipswich Golf Club and were always ready to give positive support for Club activities. This shield replaces the Margo Cooney Salver which was donated by the Cooney family in memory of their daughter Margo, and was awarded from 1972 to 2005.

Villers Bretonneux Cup

This trophy is named after a World War I campaign in an area near a French town. It perpetuates the memory of the Australian Imperial Forces in France and Flanders and in particular the 11,000 of them who fell in France and had no known graves. Ipswich Returned Service people started the Ipswich Event in 1932. Over the years, the All Services Bowl and Vincent Beirne Memorial Cup were added to the day. Initially, at the end of each playing of this event, the Last Post was played to remember lost friends. Sponsorship is from the RSL IPSWICH SUB BRANCH.

In 2012, the date of playing is **Saturday 11th August 2012**.

City of Ipswich Open

Saturday 29th & Sunday 30th September 2012.

This Event started as a Pro Am in 1982 and grew to be the second ranked Tournament on the Sunshine Circuit. In 1987, the Open became a 36 Hole Amateur Event and now has a high profile within Queensland Amateur golf. It is a sanctioned AB/WK 36 Hole Event. Trophies are allocated for each day with the major trophies given for the 36 hole events.

Twilight Golf

A 9 hole competition played Friday afternoons. Single Stableford format open to all players with an AGU handicap.

Centenary Cup / Plate

Sunday 25th November 2012.

The Centenary Cup and Plate events were inaugurated in 1997 to celebrate 100 years of Golf at Ipswich Golf Club. Players winning a “major event” in 2012 will be invited by letter to play for the Cup, all other players will play for the Plate. The presentation after the game is preceded by a 12 noon shotgun start. Eddie and Marie McCaffrey are generous sponsors of the day.

Ken Davidson Memorial Day

Saturday 25th August 2012.

Ken commenced his golfing career as a caddie at the original Ipswich Golf Club at Limestone Park in the 1930s. He was a Club Champion on numerous occasions and became a State Representative player. He eventually turned Professional and was employed at the club as its Professional until 1980. He was a tireless worker for the club, much of it voluntary. His wife, Audrey, and his family have donated this Memorial Trophy, “Ipswich was Ken’s Club”. The event is a 4BBB Stroke.

Kevin O’Brien Medallion / Eclectic

Long time former member and Patron, Kevin O’Brien, was instrumental in introducing the following two competitions and running them for many years almost single handedly. Each event runs for the whole year.

Kev. O’Brien Medallion: Each player averages a minimum of 12 gross scores from the 15 Eclectic Rounds. A ranking is produced and the lowest gross average is awarded the “Kev. O’Brien Medallion”.

2012 ECLECTIC: The 2012 Event will run over the 15 Single Stoke Events as listed in the fixtures. It will run in A, B & C Grades. Handicap used and a player’s grade is per the final round. An entry fee of \$5 applies.

Mug of Mugs

Saturday 15th December 2012.

Each month a closed Single Stroke Event (Monthly Mug) is held and the three Grade Nett winners are entitled to select a Voucher, Pewter Mug or a Club Shirt as a Trophy. In December, these winners are invited to play for the annual “Mug of Mugs” trophy. Current handicaps apply and normal count back procedures apply if needed.

GENERAL NOTES FOR THE GUIDANCE OF MEMBERS

MEMBERSHIP

There are many **membership options** to cater for many and varied situations. Full ordinary membership for 12 months incorporates “full voting rights” and is by far the most popular. Six day members opt to not play on Saturdays but this can still occur for an extra fee. Pathway membership caters for the worker who can only play once a month and does not see value in paying the full yearly subscription. Monthly membership also provides another option. Different payment options exist with monthly direct debit now proving popular.

Membership options are continually being reviewed / revised by the Board.

Latest information on membership can be obtained from reception.

Please update the office if **personal details change** – address, phone numbers or e-mail address.

Resignation should be in writing and addressed to the Secretary Manager.

NEW MEMBERS

Intending new Members should be directed to Reception to obtain nomination forms or obtain these from the web site. New Members will be advised of their Membership Number and the use of the Golf Link Card. New members may need to submit score cards in order to establish a Golf Aust. Handicap.

Immediately a “Nominee” is accepted for membership it is normally the responsibility of the “Proposer” and /or the “Secunder” to see that the new Member is introduced to other Members, is informed of all the pertinent Rules governing the operation of the Club, and is sufficiently advanced in the knowledge of the Rules of Golf to be competent to perform the duties of “Marker” for a fellow competitor. Please play with your “Nominees” until they are so prepared.

An “Induction Program” will be in operation in 2012.

PLAYER INFORMATION

- **A Club Newsletter** will be produced every 4-6 weeks and placed on the website and in hard copy form in the Pro Shop. Both the Captain and President contribute newsletters. Players are expected to read these newsletters as an eclectic mix of information regarding IGC is presented.
-
- Regularly check the **Notice Board** located at the Pro Shop for updated Club information sometimes involving invitations to other club events. This board is also used to advertise daily “Conditions of Play”, Upcoming Events and Competition Results. On Saturdays, a Daily Notices Board will inform players of additional game conditions like pin positions / tees used as well as more Club News. The white board at the pro-shop will display temporary local rules.

COMPETITION DETAILS

- While the Fixture Book contains the events planned at the time of printing, the ‘**Events Board**’ outside the Pro Shop should be regularly checked, as additional Club sanctioned events / wet weather may necessitate programme changes.
-
- **Electronic timesheets** are now used for all competition and social rounds. These timesheets can be accessed via website or touch screens located in the clubhouse and golf shop or by phoning the golf shop directly(38120488 / Ext 1} These timesheets become active at 8am, 15 days prior to competition date. They also become inactive at 12 midnight the day prior to the event. Any cancellations after this time must be phoned through to the golf shop.
- **If you are not on the time sheet you have no rights.**
-
- **Competition Players have priority on the Course.** The pro-shop will endeavour to manage play so as to not have social players in the competition field.
- **Open and Invitation Days** as listed in the fixtures involve a competition fee of \$10 and no other fee.

DRESS CODE

Men

Minimum standard of dress is:

- Long Trousers or Tailored Shorts
- Collared or Golf Designer Sports Shirt (Singlets are not permitted)
- Sport Socks (predominantly white)

Proper and appropriate footwear is to be worn at all times on the golf course (thongs or sandals are not permitted)

Women

Minimum standard of dress is:

- Skirts, and divided skirts and shorts are to be of a reasonable length (No lycra shorts or bike pants)
- Shirts must have a collar or be a golf designer shirt (No singlets or backless tops)
- Proper and appropriate footwear is to be worn at all times on the golf course (thongs or sandals are not permitted)

SOCIAL PLAY

All Social players (including Members playing Social Rounds) **MUST** report to the Pro Shop and record their names on the Electronic Time Sheet / Register at the Pro Shop so staff can effectively monitor Course usage. Players **MUST** follow the directions of the Pro Shop staff re tee used. Mid-Week Competition players are advised to book times on the Electronic Time Sheet to avoid delays in getting on to the Golf Course. **Players playing a social round are to hit only one ball in play.**

TROPHIES

Most Trophies are in the form of **vouchers** valid for purchases at the Pro Shop / Clubhouse (food and drink). Vouchers not received at Presentations will normally be available at the Pro-Shop soon after the event. For Championship / Honour Board / Major Events, vouchers are presented at the Presentation Dinner in December. In selected Sponsored Events, trophies may take the form of vouchers from the Company, or they may be prizes supplied by the Company. The Board and Members are appreciative of the generosity of those who continue to sponsor our golfing program.

The names of Players who have won balls in Pin Shots or the Ball Rundown will be recorded on the Results Sheets located in the Pro Shop or Clubhouse. These Balls may be collected from the Pro Shop. If not collected, all balls and vouchers from the month will be automatically transferred onto membership cards early in the next month. This can then be used in the clubhouse for food and drink, or for purchases in the Golf Shop (excluding green fees and competition fees).

Monthly Mug Winners have the choice of a Mug, Embroidered Shirt or Voucher. Players recording a **Hole in One** receive an extra dozen balls. **Eagles on Par 4's** receive 6 balls. Both assume normal playing conditions with the par 3 played from the normal tee to the normal green (no temporaries) and the eagle not recorded in a team ambrose / texan 2 ball situation or in the time of preferred lies.

TUESDAYS

Ladies Competitions are played on Tuesday mornings.

THURSDAY COMPETITION

Thursday Competitions in 2012 will be 18 Hole Single Stableford Medley Event. Some 'Open' Events exist on Thursdays around Easter and Christmas.

“CONTINUOUS MIDWEEK 9 HOLE EVENT”

On Mondays, Tuesdays (afternoon only), Wednesdays and Fridays, an Open 9 Hole Continuous event is played. Cost is \$5. Scores are converted to an 18 hole equivalent score using the table supplied by GA and sent to Golf Link for Handicapping purposes. All events in 2012 will be Single Stableford events. Alternate 9's will be played each week providing conditions allow. This event may run for 2 weeks on a particular 9 when there are interruptions (e.g. Weather/ Renovations).

TWILIGHT CLUB

This completion is being trialled in the Summer months to allow members to play a quick 9 holes after work. The opposite 9 holes to the midweek competition is played.

BLACK MARKER CHALLENGE

Test your golfing ability by playing this event which is usually the last Friday of the month. The course is set up to test even the skilled player. BOQ is a very generous sponsor providing trophies that can only be described as extremely generous.

STANDARD CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. Competitions are “open” to amateur players with a GA handicap. Players from other clubs cannot win “closed” or “Honour Board” Events.
2. All competitions will be under the management and control of the Golf Management Committee (GMC). The Golf Operation Manager is a member of the GMC. The Captain or his delegate (e.g. Golf Operations Manager) may make decisions in situations where the full committee is not available. Such Decisions are final and deemed to be the decision of the full GMC.
3. The GMC reserves the right to alter the Conditions of Play or even the gazetted program when required.
4. Competition play will adopt the Rules of Golf as set by the RNA of St Andrews, the local rules of IGC and the Conditions of Play for that event (available on the Golf Shop notice board). **All “count backs” will employ the GA count back procedure which views the back 9, last 6 holes, last 3 holes and if required, hole by hole backwards from the 18th hole.**
5. The Golf Operations Manager (or delegate) has the responsibility of ensuring the smooth running of any event. From time to time, starting an event may involve shifting groups between the 1st and 10th tees or even shifting players between groups in order to dispatch the field in an efficient manner. Players chosen time slot / playing group will be honoured the majority of the time.
6. Event **registration** must be before tee-off and should be a **minimum 20 minutes** before that tee-off time. On some occasions, the starter may call the field a few minutes early.
7. The electronic time sheet becomes inactive at midnight before an event. Cancellations on the day should be performed by phoning 38120488 (Ext 1) as soon as possible so as to allow the starter to substitute “stand by” players.
8. The Golf Operations manager (or delegate) will monitor “pace of play” issues by acting as Course Marshal. All players are required to act upon any slow play advice issued by the marshal.
9. The Low Handicapper of each group is responsible for that group following standard procedures of course etiquette, rules of golf and pace of play.
10. Completed score cards are to be handed to the golf shop no later than 15 minutes after the completion of the round.
11. Disputes of any kind need to be in writing and submitted to the GMC no later than 15 minutes after the completion of the round.
12. Laser Devices measuring **distance** only are permitted at any event.
13. Safety Flags should be used as supplied on holes with blind tee shots.
14. All play will cease (as per the rules of golf rule 6-8) when the weather siren is sounded indicating lightning is in the vicinity. **Any player has the option of ceasing play independently if they believe lightning is a danger.**
15. The notice board outside the golf shop will display tee colour / pin positions in use for the daily competition. The white board will display any temporary local rules.

PLAYERS RESPONSIBILITY

BE INFORMED: Your fixture book provides an accurate calendar of events. Players need to also read the temporary local rules board (white board), local rules sheets available from the Pro- Shop, Conditions of Play sheets on the Golf Shop notice board as well as the regular newsletters produced. The IGC website contains some of this information.

Mobile Telephones: Mobile Telephones must either be switched off or in silent mode while playing and should only be used in cases of emergencies.

Half Way House: The club has provided a snack box in the club house for the convenience of members at the half way mark in their games. It has done so with the intention that play would not be slowed in any way. While players are encouraged to use this facility, they must ensure that they do not lose their place in the field, slow down play in any way, or cause the extension of the competition playing time. A drinks cart operates most Saturdays and provides an extra service supplying food and drink.

Motorised Buggies: The use of motorised buggies and other ride-on vehicles on the Course is subject to the direction of the Golf Operations Manager and the Course Superintendent. Buggies are not to be driven within a distance of **5 metres** of Greens and **2 metres** of Bunkers or Tees. Buggies are to be driven slowly and slopes / causeways negotiated with care. The minimum requirement for a person to be driving a buggy is "learner's permit". **Small children are not to drive buggies.**

PRACTICE FACILITIES

For practice on the Course, the registration book in the golf shop must be signed. The pro-shop staff will advise as to which tee is appropriate. Players are to hit only one ball when playing a social practice round. The Pro Shop provides baskets of Practice Balls for range use. The chipping green beside the pro-shop provides an area for short and longer shots as well as bunker play.

SLOW PLAY

Remember, you should try to be just behind the players ahead and not just ahead of the players behind. If your group is well behind the group in front by a considerable distance and not likely to catch up, consider calling faster groups through. Groups booking early morning games...remember that the pace of play for the whole day is determined by you.

A **course marshal** will at times monitor slow play .If your group is warned for slow play, every effort to "catch up" must be made. In this way further penalties will be avoided.

COURSE ETIQUETTE

Players placed on their honour.

Golf is a game where normally there is no referee or umpire, so players are placed on their honour "to play the game" in a sporting and fair manner. Remember you are competing against the whole field not just your immediate opponent, so adhering to the Rules of Golf is of paramount importance.

The low marker in the group is expected to monitor the situation outlined, as well as "slow play" if applicable.

Silence:

Players must observe silence, and remain still when a Partner, an Opponent or any other Player is about to make a shot. Players driving motorised golf carts should also respect other players in the course of play.

Repairs to Course:

Please carry a Sand Bucket and use sand (and displaced grass, where appropriate) to repair your divots on and off the Fairways. Also, please take care to repair Plug Marks on Greens.(particularly 14th green) The efforts of Players to repair additional divots and plug marks is appreciated.

Bunkers:

Players are required to rake all marks including footprints in the bunker. After being used, **Rakes should be left in the middle of bunker** parallel to the line of play if possible.

Trees and Shrubs:

Players should avoid damaging the trees and shrubs growing on and around the Course. White staked trees invite 1 club length relief.

Code of Behaviour

All players are expected to behave in a civil and sensible manner on and off the course. Players representing IGC at an away venue are subject to the same scrutiny. In most behaviour violations, a first warning will be given. Further indiscretions may result in the member appearing before a committee of Board representatives. Suspension may result in extreme cases.

HANDICAPPING SYSTEM

Ipswich Golf Club is linked to 'Golf Link', the Golf Australia national computerised handicapping system. The club makes every effort to enter scores on the day of a competition in an endeavour to keep handicaps current.. Consequently, **the playing handicap to be used is the one displayed on the Golf Link system at the time of playing**, unless directed otherwise by the Captain or his representative. Queries on the accuracy of any handicap should be directed to the Golf Operations Manager or Club Captain.

Changes to the Golf Australia Handicap System will be progressively introduced over the next few years. Latest memos will be posted on the pro-shop noticeboard.

Rules of Golf

1. **The 'Rules of Golf' Book is available free of charge from the Pro-Shop. A new rules book has just been released. (Nov. 2011)**
2. Daily competitions are governed by the Rules of Golf as set down by the R & A as well as the local rules of the club.

Complaints / Suggestions

1. All complaints / suggestions should be made in writing and be addressed to the Secretary Manager.
2. Complaints / suggestions will be reviewed at the next monthly meeting.

Safety Information

The Workplace Health and Safety Act requires an employer to maintain a safe working environment. The Ipswich Golf Club has adopted safe work practices. The following procedures have been introduced to prevent injury to staff from golf balls and players from lightning strikes.

Greens Maintenance

When the flag has been removed, the Green is out of play and golfers are not to hit to the Green until the flag is replaced and Green Staff are clear of the Green.

Fairways and Rough Maintenance

Golfers must wait for an approaching vehicle or mower to pass behind or out of range before playing their shots. Alternatively, the Operator may call golfers to play their shots. In all other situations, before playing a shot, golfers must receive acknowledgement from Ground Staff.

Greens staff have "right of way" during their normal operations.

Lightning Siren

Play is to cease immediately when the siren is sounded. **Any player has the option of ceasing play if they perceive lightning to be a danger.**

JUNIOR GOLF

The Junior Member is an integral part of any successful Golf Club. This point is not lost at the Ipswich Golf Club. Junior members of the Club have available to them many opportunities which social golfers are unable to enjoy. Young golfers begin their training at the weekly clinics where the basics of the golf swing are practised. From this introductory level clinic, young players graduate to social games with golfing members. It is the responsibility of all new members to read and understand the points listed in the 'Course Etiquette' and 'Conditions of Play' sections of the Fixture Book prior to playing on the Golf Course. Once Juniors have a Golf Australia Handicap and have an understanding of the Rules of Golf and of Course and Playing etiquette, they can graduate to playing in club competitions in the company of a Senior player. Senior players have the responsibility of monitoring their understanding of the Game, their application of the Rules and their accurate use of the Scorecard. They should also spend time learning the "Rules of Golf" and seeking clarification of them from their senior playing partners.

Conditions of Play

1. These conditions are to be read in conjunction with the 'Conditions of Play' and 'Etiquette' sections in the front of this Fixture Book.
2. All Competition Fees are payable in advance. Penalty for Non-payment is Disqualification.
3. The Committee may disqualify un-financial players.
4. Committee alone has the power to make alterations to the Programme.
5. All Ladies are strongly advised to return at least three 18 Hole scores annually.
6. To be eligible to play in Competitions, a player must have a current Golf Australia Handicap.
7. The low marker in each group is asked to be responsible for the Rules and Etiquette of golf and the Speed of Play.
8. Correct attire must be worn at all times on the Course and in the Club House.
9. Before Teeing off, all players are required to report to the Starter 20 minutes prior to commencing a Competition Round, or to the Pro Shop before playing a Social Round.
10. Repairs to Course. Please carry and use sand buckets to repair all divots and please repair plug marks on Greens.
11. Motorised Buggies and other ride-on vehicles can be used in all Club competitions, including Championships.
12. Etiquette. It is courteous to advise your opposition if you intend to use a Caddie.

Foursomes Competitions

*In Mixed events the Ladies Handicap fractions will be used.

CANADIAN FOURSOMES

Men 1/2, Ladies 3/8 of Combined Handicap Played as Foursomes, except that both players play tee shots at every Hole, and afterwards continue with whichever ball they nominate, the partner hitting the selected ball.

CHAPMAN FOURSOMES

Men 1/2, Ladies 1/3 of Combined Handicap Both players play tee shots, hit their own ball a second time and then select the better ball. The partner hits the selected ball, and thereafter the ball is struck alternately until holed.

AMERICAN FOURSOMES

Men 1/2, Ladies 1/3 of Combined Handicap Both players play tee shots at each Hole, and then play a second stroke with their partner's ball. One ball is then selected and play proceeds as in Foursomes with the owner of the ball selected playing the third stroke. With cards from other clubs, the Par, the Australian Women's Course Rating (AWCR) and the Calculated Course Rating (CCR) of the day are also required.
